

Swiss h0m layout under construction (Jaap Stuurman)

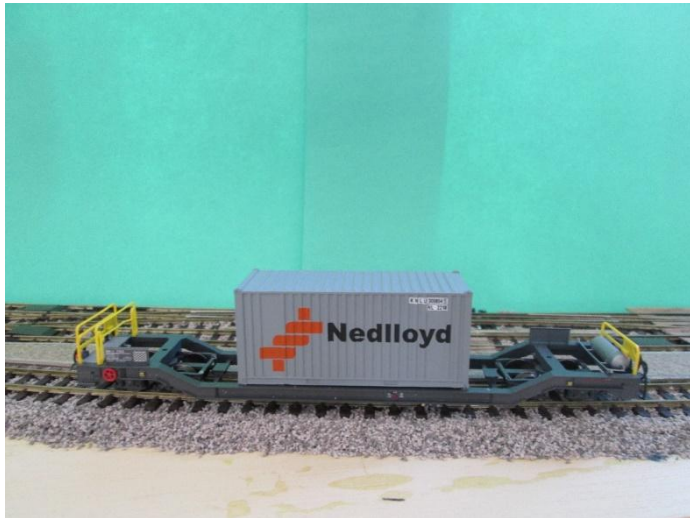
I started building a few modules for a Swiss layout in H0m a while ago. But I do not want to recreate the Rhätische bahn like everyone else and have plunged into the only narrow-gauge line of the SBB (the Brünigbahn) around 1988/1989. This railway also partly has a rack section, which should make it even more fun.



The beer wagon of the Eichhof brewery from Lucerne is a conversion of a wagon from the Rhätische Bahn and a 'loner' on the Brünig line. (this car is currently being restored in Stansstad).



The tank wagon is a conversion of a TT model and once again after a single specimen on the Brünigbahn.



This is a joke made up from a Berninabahn container wagon with a Nedlloyd container, this will probably never have been seen in Switzerland, but I just like it because I used to sail for Nedlloyd. And also to tease Ted a little, he also is an old Nedlloyd sailor.



This is the first unit of the new layout under construction, the station building hasn't been fitted on the baseboard and the baseboard needs to be put on end to fit the wiring.
